

### **LEADING MEANS GROWING**

Tony Dungy, in his book, *The Mentor Leader*, quotes an old Irish proverb: "You've got to do your own growing, no matter how tall your grandfather was." Surveying where we have come from as leaders, where we are and where we are going, this is the time for us to grow into our role as influencers to the people who are alive in this present generation.



Because many are confused about so many issues, we must stand **compassionately firm** among a people who cannot see the light of the gospel because the enemy has blinded their minds to truth.

It can *feel* overwhelming when we consider the astonishing changes happening all around us, on every side; but it is *not* overwhelming to us because it is not overwhelming to our God.



David shared these feelings of being engulfed by the seemingly out-of-control events surrounding Absalom's rebellion. The nation was in peril, David's acceptance as king was in question, his own family was torn by competing and divisive narratives. His emotions were swirling and unstable as he wondered about the future. It is possible the news of Absalom's death at Joab's hand had just reached him. In his despair, he picks up his harp and writes a psalm to encourage the tabernacle priests and set the tone for the nation's reunification.



"When my heart is overwhelmed; Lead me to the rock that is higher than I.

For You have been a shelter for me, A strong tower from the enemy. I will abide in Your tent forever; I will trust in the shelter of Your wings."

David acknowledged his fear, but he knew God lives above the changing world, unflustered by the demanding cries of rebellious creatures, unmoved by the fickle changes in administrations, unafraid of a nation's slipping away from His favor. Higher than our concerns about the future is God's unyielding and sovereign grip on the destiny of His creation. This one truth should calm our hearts and minds

and provide the 'shelter' we need to protect and strengthen our confidence in Him.

The faltering king transitioned to the mindset of a skilled and certain leader because he spent time in God's presence. "Your tent" was, in David's thoughts, the place where God lived. "Your wings" was a reference to the golden cherubim on the ark of the covenant. Our greatest asset in these shifting and rudderless times is God's presence through a personal walk with Him each

day.

It is there, at His feet, we will grow into the leaders He needs for such a time as this!
